Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Modernizing Advanced Imaging to Expand Oral Surgery Initiative in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Marquette University located at 1801 West Wisconsin Avenue, Milwaukee, WI 53233.

The funding would be used to acquire advanced dental imaging infrastructure. Federal funds would support: (1) acquisition and installation of cone beam computed tomography (CBCT) and panoramic imaging systems essential for contemporary oral and maxillofacial surgery (OMFS) and the related renovation of existing space to safely accommodate the advanced imaging technology. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because modern imaging technology will enhance diagnostic precision, patient safety, and surgical efficiency while strengthening hands-on training for future providers. The modernized diagnostic capabilities provided by the CBCT and panoramic imaging systems will ensure care consistent with current standards of care.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with, and supportive of, NIST's mission and aligned with one or more of the functions and activities described in section 272 of title 15, United States Code
