Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting community project funding for the Village of West Milwaukee's Beloit Road Reconstruction and Utilities Project. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Village of West Milwaukee, located at 4755 W Beloit Rd, West Milwaukee, WI 53214.

The proposed project would reconstruct a .53 section of the roadway in the Village of West Milwaukee on Beloit Road from S. 56th Street to W. Greenfield Ave. The project would remove the existing pavement & base course, repair failed base areas, and replace the pavement with 14" of base course and 8" of concrete pavement. It also includes the replacement of associated water mains and lead laterals under the affected roadway. The average daily traffic is 10,700.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it would help reconstruct an extremely deteriorated road in a diverse and low-income community. The project will create jobs both directly through construction and indirectly through increased economic activity in the area, and help restore a vital roadway which serves residents, tourists and visitors to the area.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C.5305(a)(1), 5305(a)(2), 5305(a)(4), and/or 5305(a)(5).
