I am requesting funding for the Housing Authority of the City of Milwaukee's Public Safety Department Technology and Equipment for Crime Prevention Project in Fiscal Year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Milwaukee located at 200 East Wells Street, Room 100, Milwaukee, WI 53202.

The funding would be used to procure and install updated technology and equipment including security cameras, alarm systems, access control systems, and equipment such as bullet-proof vests, public safety vehicles, and lighting enhancements and security fencing to enhance security at public housing properties throughout the City.
