USCIS's Milwaukee Office is Moving

MILWAUKEE — The U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services' Milwaukee Field Office is moving to 310 W. Wisconsin Ave., Suite 850 W, Milwaukee, WI 53203. The new USCIS facility will replace the current office located at 310 E. Knapp St. in Milwaukee.

Thursday, October 3, 2024, will be the last day of operations at the USCIS office on 310 E. Knapp St. There will be no in-person services available at the field office October 4 through October 18. USCIS services will resume at the new office location at 310 W. Wisconsin Ave., Suite 850 W on Monday, October 21, 2024.

The new 23,475 sq. ft. office will provide primarily naturalization and adjustment of status (green card) interviews and adjudications, as well as administrative naturalization ceremonies for USCIS customers in the state of Wisconsin. The office will have 30 employees and serve approximately 250 customers per week.

The **Milwaukee Application Support Center**, which is co-located on site with the USCIS Milwaukee Field Office, will remain open at the current location at 310 E. Knapp St. through Friday, October 18. The ASC will open at the new office location at 310 W. Wisconsin Ave., Suite 850 W on Monday, October 21. Application support centers provide biometric services appointments (such as fingerprints, photographs, and electronic signatures) for individuals requesting an immigration benefit with USCIS.

USCIS field offices and application support centers do not allow walk-ins; appointments are required. Members of the public in need of emergency immigration services or an appointment can submit an [online appointment request form](#) or reach out to the USCIS Contact Center at 1-800-375-5283.
