FEDERAL DISASTER DECLARATION FACT SHEET

SEPTEMBER 11, 2025

Today, September 11, 2025, President Donald J. Trump granted a Major Disaster Declaration for the State of Wisconsin triggering the release of Federal funds to help individuals recover from severe storms, straight-line winds, flooding, and mudslides that occurred August 9-12, 2025. Details of the disaster declaration and assistance programs are as follows:
