Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Active Living & Longevity Infrastructure Strategy (ALLIS) project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of West Allis, located at 7525 W. Greenfield Avenue, West Allis, WI 53214.

The funding would be used to reconstruct and modernize property at 7220 W. National Avenue into a public facility in order to co-locate the Southwest Suburban Health Department—which serves the communities of West Allis and Greenfield-- and the highly utilized West Allis Senior Center which serves the city of West Allis and the village of West Milwaukee. The existing Senior Center (built in 1955) and Health Department building (built in 1977) both require substantial capital repairs, lack full ADA accessibility, and are not fully sprinklered. Rather than investing millions of dollars into aging and inefficient facilities, a new facility would help create a safer, fully accessible, and operationally efficient long-term solution.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds. Among its many benefits, it would enhance safety for all the many residents who access services through the two agencies through new fire suppression systems and modern building systems. It would also provide a fully ADA-accessible, single-story facility that will allow seniors, families, and individuals with disabilities with easier access to both agencies. The new facility would also allow for expanded public health clinical capacity, including immunizations, screenings, and chronic disease programming as well as senior center offerings. Because the Southwest Suburban Health Department serves multiple communities within WI-04, this project strengthens public health infrastructure regionally

The project has a federal nexus because funding requested is consistent with the goals of one or more of the following eligible uses of the Community Development Fund (CDF): 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(1), 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2), 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(4), and 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(5).
