Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Village of Whitefish Bay Lead Service Line Replacements project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Village of Whitefish Bay, WI located at 5300 N. Marlborough Drive, Whitefish Bay, WI 53217-5399.

The funding would be used for replacing 144 lead service lines and approximately one mile of aging water main. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it directly supports the Village's compliance with federal regulations regarding lead in drinking water and fulfills Congress's intent to eliminate lead exposure in drinking water.

Lead is recognized by federal health agencies as a neurotoxin with no safe level of exposure. The LCRI emphasizes protecting vulnerable populations such as children under six and pregnant women who face irreversible developmental and cognitive harm from even low levels of exposure. This project is a compliance-driven, federally necessary activity to satisfy EPA regulations under the Safe Drinking Water Act.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. 300j-12.
