- **Emergency Assistance**

- **\*IMPACT 211 Wisconsin:** Dial 211 if you are experiencing property damage (ex. Flooded basements or collapsed walls) this number will get you connected to various community and assistance programs – In case, they don't answer – You can fill out property damage report on their website -
